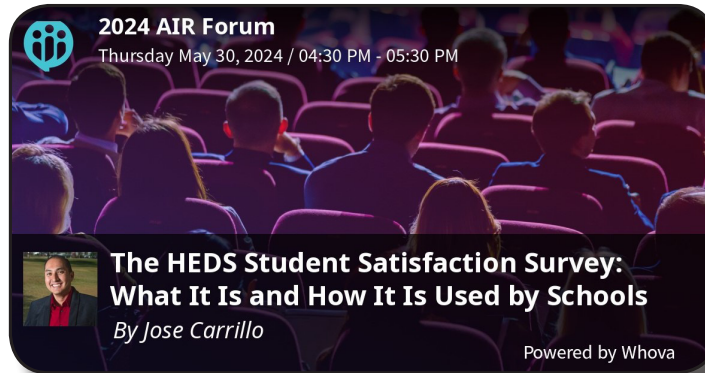
Jose Carrillo and Oliver Zambrano presented at the 2024 Association for Institutional Research Forum in May 2024 in Denver, CO.
