This project modernizes 3 small buildings that constitute the heart of the campus. Two of these building were part of the original campus (1962): Bldg 2 and Bldg 3. Including Bldg 800 (constructed in 1971) these buildings account for 11,976 of lecture space (25,319 WSCH of the campus total capacity of 69,746 WSCH), 5,470 asf of laboratory space, 4,150 asf of office space, and 839 asf of all other space. In total the project modernizes 22,535 asf/32,286gsf of space by addressing code issues, infrastructure that has outlived its life, program and technology support issues to support the changing in teaching/learning methods that have occurred since the buildings were first constructed.
